Revised Goals

- "All Students Can Read Well"
 - i. 10% increase at or above benchmark
 - ii. 10% decrease in students scoring "well below"
 - iii. All students will improve by 10% increase above 40th percentile on the MAP Growth Assessment
- 8% decrease in students considered chronically absent
- o 100% of students will complete IB "end of unit tasks"
- o 5 workshops for families all district and schools are more responsive and inclusive
- All students participate in at least 4 college and career ready experiences

Reading Partners

- Overview of Program: individualized instruction to students in grades K-4 who are reading 6 months to 2.5 years below grade level - determined by STAR assessment.
- Three curriculum levels aligned with Science of Reading and Common Core standards that progress from basic phonics through higher-order comprehension skills.
- Trained Volunteer Tutors
- Each student receives twice-weekly 1:1 tutoring sessions, each for 45 minutes
- Assessments are administered at the beginning, middle and end of program alongside placement assessments and other grade-level progress monitoring tools
- FY23- FY24 school year:
 - 39 enrolled students
 - # of sessions per student: 24

- 64% attendance
- K,1st, 2nd Grade Subdomains good growth
- 3&4 Grade Level Equivalency data shows the gap is closing between where students are currently reading and grade level reading skills

Program Goals & Current Numbers

- Student Enrollment Goal: 50
- Avg attendance percentage goal: 85%
- Current student enrollment: 24
 - In pipeline:15
 - Total:39
- Avg Attendance 77.8%
- Program permission slips sent home, progress reports are sent home
